HALF DAY SUMMER PROGRAM



Applied Behavioral Concepts and Premier Schools have formed the Premier Collaborations Child Development Center.

Premier Collaborations is pleased to announce a Summer Program designed to meet the needs of children diagnosed with PDD, an autism spectrum disorder, Downs syndrome or other developmental delay during the months of June and July.

Our program is designed to work on the skills children need to participate in a typical school/preschool program in addition to specialized instruction.

Children will be invited to join in multi-sensory strategies to enhance learning through varying modalities. Children will use activities such as music and art each day to learn and reinforce daily lesson plans.

Program Description

The program begins with circle time and interactive listening skills in a small group setting. This will be followed by a table time activity all focusing on sensory experiences, social skills and thematic learning.

Music! Art! Social Skills!

Music and follow-along songs will get the children moving and using their muscles. Each day children will explore sensory items such as textures and other sensory items (beans, rice, water, sand, etc.) in supervised play and art activities which encourage the development of fine motor skills.

A snack will be served in a typical classroom setting however; children on special diets are welcome to bring in their own snacks. Daily art activities will focus on learning how to use crayons, scissors, tearing paper and gluing to make various projects.

Weather permitting, children will spend time with age matched peers on the playground to work on

gross motor skills, including riding tricycles and climbing on the slides and jungle gym. During inclement weather, the children will engage in indoor group games in the large indoor atrium complete with mats, climbing toys and a balance beam.

Social skills will be encouraged daily as children will be separated in supervised play groups and included with age-appropriate typical peers.. We will use simple games to work on social skills, turn taking and cooperative play.

Afternoon Care

In addition to continuing the camp setting, parents may choose to enroll in afternoon services of individual skills instruction or additional hours of inclusion. Please contact us to secure these services as we will need to determine how to meet your child's needs.

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
